

## **Grove Park Farmers Market Ambassador**

**Community Farmers Markets** is an Atlanta based 501(c)3 nonprofit organization whose mission is to develop a local food infrastructure for long term sustainability and meaningful community impact. Our purpose is to preserve, root, and grow a diverse local food culture by maintaining an authentic space for all people to share community, fair food, and healthy lifestyles while providing a sustainable living for producers who steward the earth.

CFM has a unique, four-tiered approach to food access through (1) the distribution of food through multiple market models; (2) educational outreach programming; (3) financial incentives through double SNAP and other incentive programs; and (4) vendor education and support. Through building strong partnerships with mission-critical partners in our communities and the city at large, CFM's markets and outreach models have had an extensive impact on the local food system in Atlanta.

### **Role Overview:**

The Ambassador plays a key role in ensuring a welcoming, well-organized, and smoothly run market experience. Responsibilities include market setup prior to opening, customer service during market hours, and breakdown at the close of market. At-market shifts are up to 6 hours, with optional opportunities for additional community outreach. While outreach is not required, candidates with interest or experience in this area are strongly encouraged to apply.

As a visible and trusted presence on-site, the Ambassador serves as a welcoming face of the market and an active representative within the surrounding community.

### **Schedule:**

The Grove Park Farmers Markets take place monthly throughout 2026, rotating across locations and varying schedules. Upcoming dates include:

- Saturday, June 20, 12:00-2:00 (full shift 11:00-3:00)
- Tuesday, August 4, evening

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Set up and break down market tents, tables, and equipment
- Process transactions and manage merchandise sales
- Greet customers and foster a welcoming, inclusive environment
- Build and maintain positive relationships with community members
- Support overall market operations to ensure a smooth and engaging experience

### **Qualifications:**

- Friendly, outgoing, and highly organized, with strong interpersonal skills
- Ability to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions, including heat and cold
- Commitment to equitable access to fresh, nutritious food for all, regardless of socioeconomic status

**Compensation and Benefits:**

This is a part-time position, with hours varying based on market schedules and optional outreach opportunities (approximately 6 hours per market shift). Compensation starts at \$17 per hour. This role does not include benefits.

Candidates who demonstrate strong performance in this position may have opportunities for increased responsibility and growth within the organization.

Applicants must be at least 16 years old. All hires are required to complete a W-9 form and enroll in direct deposit for payroll.
